## Hampshire FRS - Clothes Recycling Performance Report - Cumulative Totals - 2010-2021

Clothes recycling for The Fire Fighters Charity has enjoyed over 10 years of continued growth, generating £4.6million across the UK (up to March 2021), re-diverting over 26,000 tonnes of unwanted clothing away from landfill.

**Hampshire FRS** has supported us by collecting over **469 tonnes** of clothing for re-sell, reuse or recycled since **2010**. Table 1 highlights the total income generated and total weight collected, since the clothing bank was first placed at the fire station. Thank you for your contribution of **£93,183** ... totally amazing!

Chart 1 - Hampshire FRS - Cumulative Clothes Recycling Income - 2010-2021




Chart 2 – Hampshire FRS - Cumulative Clothes Recycling Income – 2010-2021
